It was your exam complete? Asked Mr Cristian

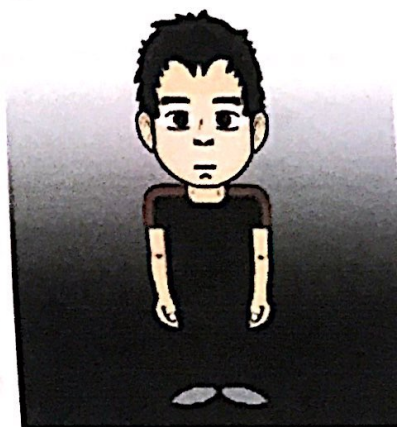
